Sunday, May 26, 2019

A BIG DAY PLANNED, SO THESE WERE NO TIME TO WASTE, AND I WENT UP PROMPTLY AT 5:30 AND STARTED BRIGHT & EARLY. I D'Y TAKE OVER AS I GATHERED HORSES. HORSES WERE STABLED WITH SLEEKER'S HELP.
